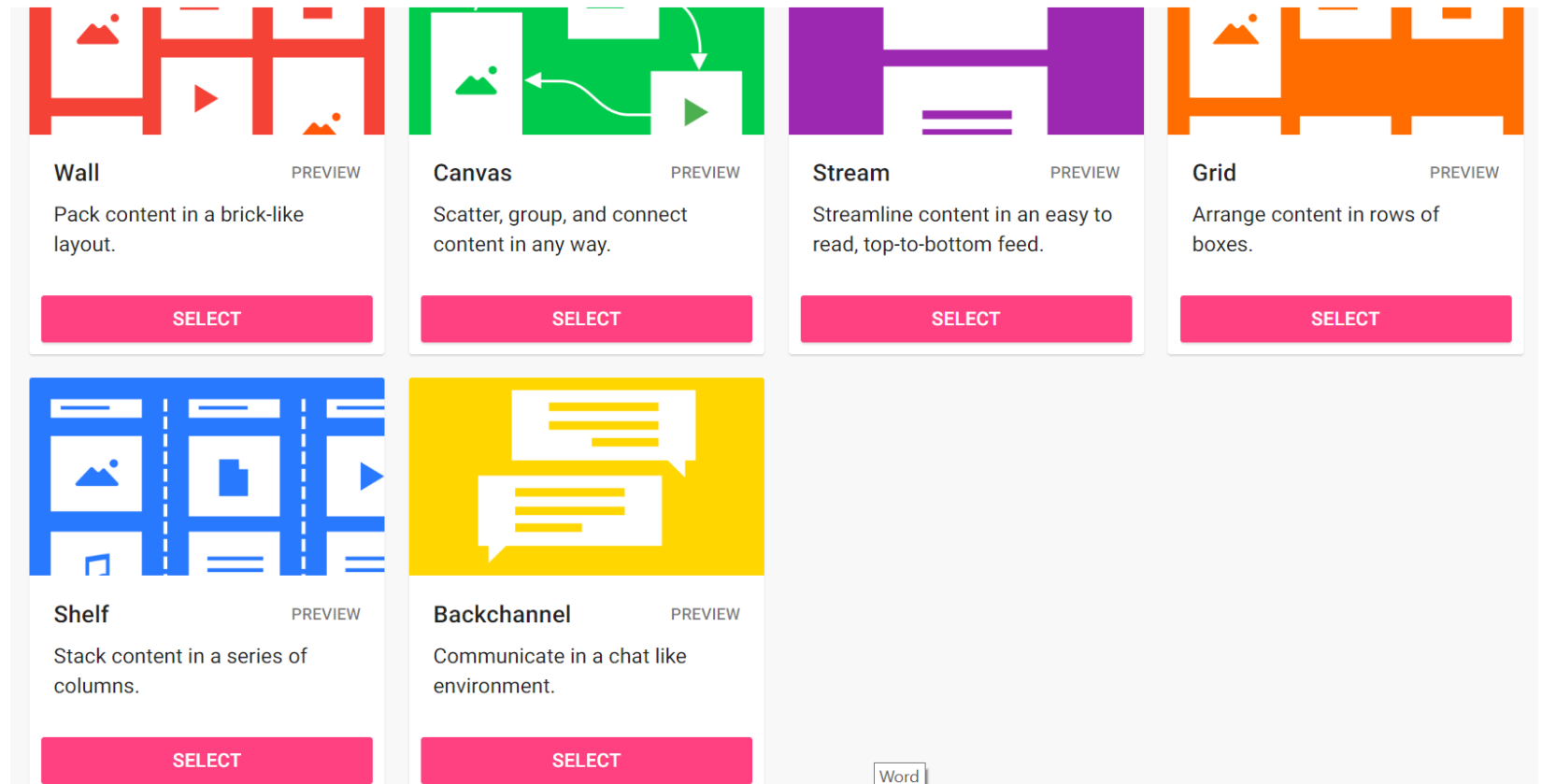

Padlet example

- Create a revision Padlet
- Follow the steps to “Build a Padlet” in your booklet - (Pg. 10)
- Add four items - text, an image, a relevant video and a voice-over
- Click - Share / Save as Image, to see what it would look like as a poster

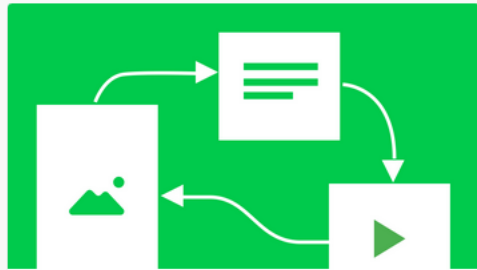

Some Padlet Ideas

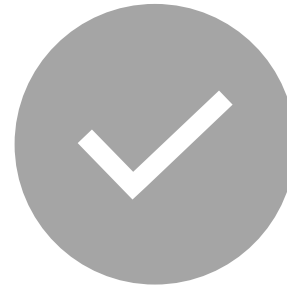


- Create a **community noticeboard** for your class
- Create a **revision board**
- Give **homework**
- Create a forum where **students can contribute / upload homework**
- **Save and store** student work.

Other features



1: Padlet uses its own QR code which can be used to gain access from iPhone / iPad app



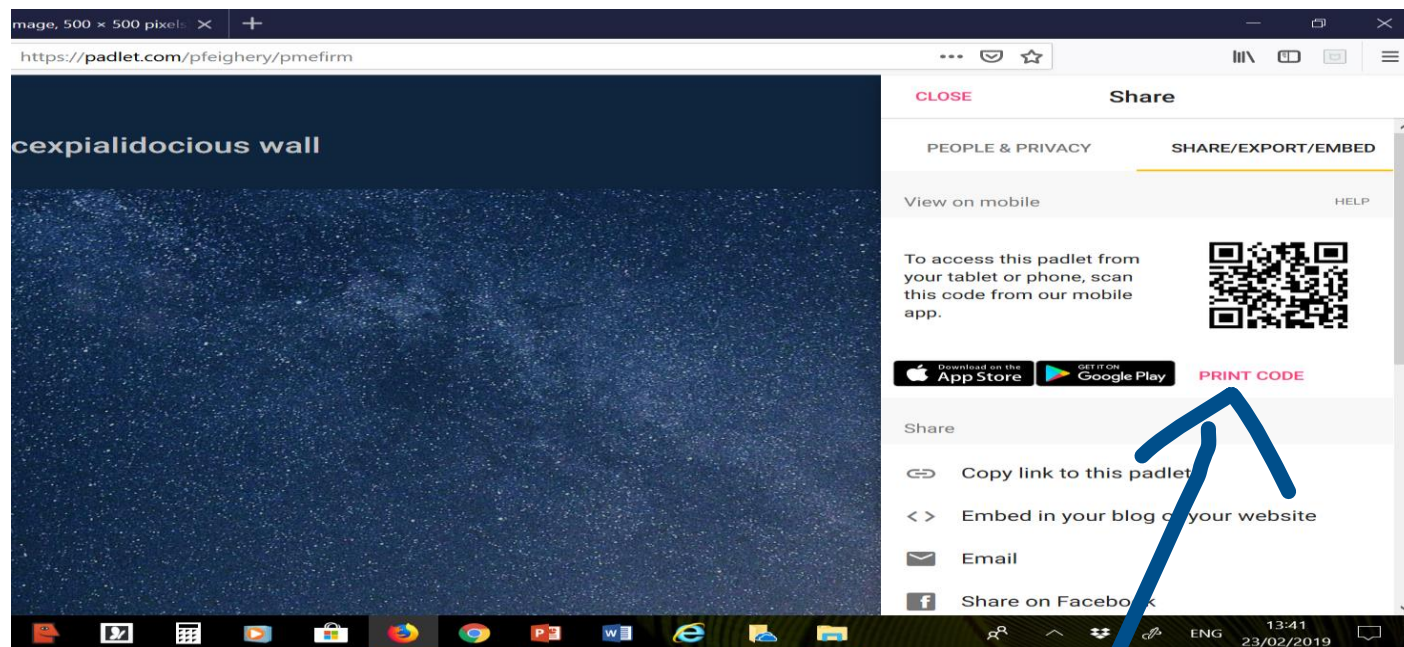
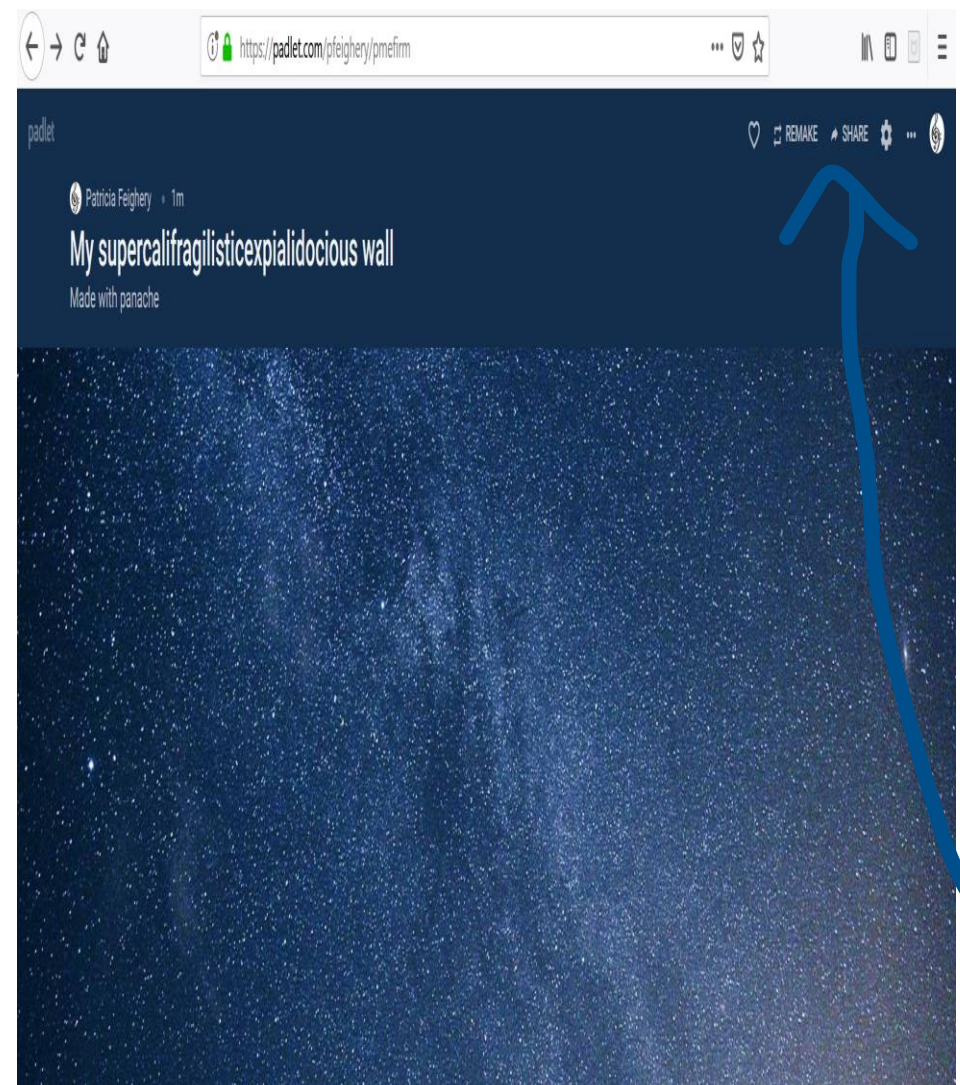
2: Padlets can be saved as an image to create a wall poster, linking learning inside / outside the classroom (use image option)



3: Can be saved as a pdf (notes) etc (use print option)

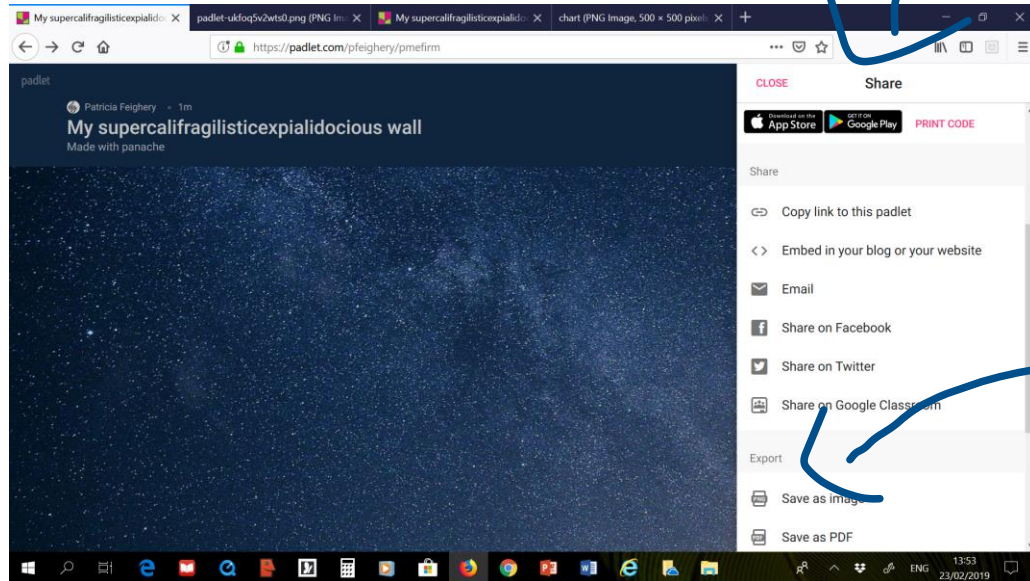


4: Can import all sounds, files, images from your PC / online sources etc



1. QR in Padlet - Click on "Share", then Print QR Code

2: Save as Poster – linking school / home learning



- Click on “Share”
- Choose Share/Export/Embed
- Scroll down to Export - “Save as Image”



- Choose "Print" – (prints as Pdf)

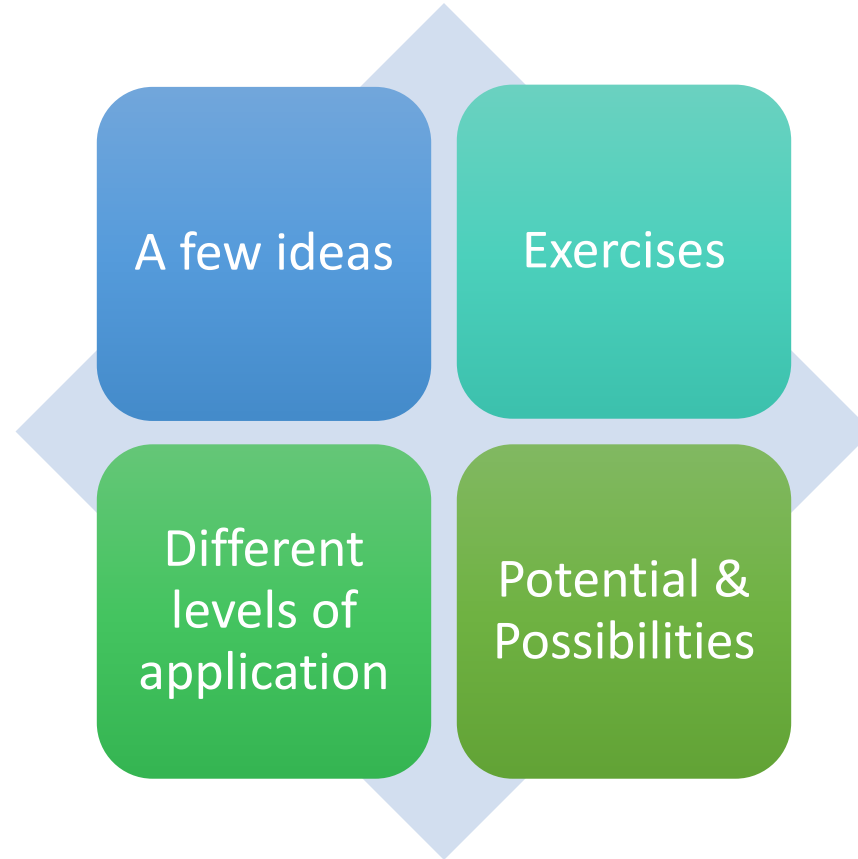
