# SUPPORT STAFF MEETING

### INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUPPORT STAFF MEETING

### MEMBER 1

You have had a great idea about having a special room for the support staff. At your meeting you say

- It would be good because it would be somewhere to sit for a cup of tea
- Somewhere to leave your coat
- Somewhere to sit down for break time
- You could even have a notice board to let everyone know things that are happening

### MEMBER 2

### You say

- You agree with Member 1
- You don't need a big room
- But you would like lockers in it to keep bags and keys and stuff like that

### MEMBER 3

You also like the idea and you say

- It would be nice to be able to leave a message for someone
- It would make it easier to get to know people if there was somewhere like this room to go to for a break.

### MEMBER 4

You say

You really like the idea but how do you get a room you cant just go and take one

### MEMBER 5

You answer Member 4

- You know that there are a couple of rooms that are not being used but they would need to be cleaned up
- You suggest going to the principal to ask for the use of one of these
- You would be happy to help clean up the room

### MEMBER 6

### You say

- You don't mind talking to the principal
- You would also help to clean up the room
- You know where there are unused chairs and old tables in the school
- You will make an appointment with the principal
- You will let people know as soon as you know anything

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### CLASS 3

This class introduces students to the idea of a Student Council and how it can provide a voice for students. Through a simulation (in which there is a part for everyone) students will see that other groups within the school structure have a mechanism by which they can suggest ideas and have them discussed. If the school has an active, effective Student Council then they would have the same mechanism open to them, which would allow their voice to be heard. This activity allows for 30 students to take part. If you have less than that in your class you can double up on the parts within the groups. You might also consider having the same person play the part of Principal for all of the meetings as it shows the pivotal role played by the principal in the running of the school.

# ACTIVITY

- Photocopy the signs and role cards on the following pages.
- Cut up the signs and role cards.
- Stick the signs up on the wall or on the back of chairs in five different parts of the room.
- Distribute a role card to each student but make sure to distribute the 5 Individual Student Role Cards randomly around the classroom
- Instruct the students to read their own role card and to go and sit with their group.
- Ask the different meeting groups to sit in consecutive order which will help to avoid confusion with the speaking order
- Once in their groups students are to read the instruction card to find out what their meeting is about.
- Students holding individual student role cards should be left on their own with nobody to talk to.

- Although there is a student council sign, there is no council in the school therefore these students have nowhere to go with their idea.
- When all of the groups have finished carrying out their meeting ask the individual students to introduce themselves according to their role card.

### FOLLOW - UP ACTIVITY

1. Ask the students to think about what a Student Council might mean to them and to write a statement or design a symbol which explains their understanding of a Student Council.

- You will say it at the next staff meeting and ask for people to volunteer to be trained to use the machines
- You think that the PE teachers would welcome something like this
- We need to think about where the machines would be kept in the school

### STUDENT 3

### You say

- You used to go to it when you were in first and second year and it was great for getting help with some of the homework
- This school does not have a club like this. It has after school study but it is too long for first and second years
- You are sure that if there was a homework club for an hour every day that the younger students would go to it and find it very useful.
- Sometimes parents can't help with the homework that students get, but other students or teachers could.
- You would like to suggest your idea to somebody but you are not sure who.
