Sample comprehension questions:

- 1) Where does Beatrice live? Uganda, Africa
- What type of house does she live in?
  A mud house (with a steel roof)
- Is Beatrice's house old or new? New

### Before they receive the goat...

- 4) What jobs did Beatrice do before the goat Mugisa arrived? Plant the fields; tend the chickens; mind the younger children; grind cassava flour (cassava is a woody shrub native to South America)
- 5) Did Beatrice go to school? No
- 6) Did she want to go to school? Why?Yes (accept various responses for why from children).
- 7) Why do you think she couldn't go to school? Her parents couldn't afford books or a uniform.
- 8) Did Beatrice think a goat was a good gift? Why? No, because it couldn't do the jobs around the house (eg. start the cooking fire, cleaning clothes, mind the children)
- What would Beatrice's job be? To look after the goat.
- 10) What did they have to do before the goat arrived? Plant pastures (grass for food) and build a shed for the goat.

### After the goat arrived...


- Why did they name the goat Mugisa? Mugisa means luck and the goat was a lucky gift.
- 12) How many kids did Mugisa have? Two
- 13) What healthy drink did Mugisa give the family? Milk
- 14) What did they do with the leftover milk? They sold it at the market.

- 16) Why was Mama happy? They had enough money to send Beatrice to school.
- 17) How did they get money to build a new, strong house? They sold one of the kids.


