

Activities include connect the dots, color by numbers, matching, and put the story in order.


#### **World Book Kids Homepage**

Use the explore function to browse high interest topics.




The feature container stores all activities and media in one easy to find place.

Tigers are mammals, animals that feed their young on mother's milk. Tigers have large, powerful bodies. A tiger's coat may range in color from brownish-yellow to orange-red. The coat is marked with black stripes. Each tiger's stripe pattern is unique, much like a human fingerprint. The fur on the throat, belly, and insides of the legs is whitish.

Adult tigers live alone. Tigers are good hunters with keen vision, hearing, and smell. They hunt mostly deer, wild cattle, antelopes, and wild pigs. Tigers hunt at night. They creep up on an animal quietly and then rush forward to pull it down.





