Task 2: Mark the advent season on the following calendars.

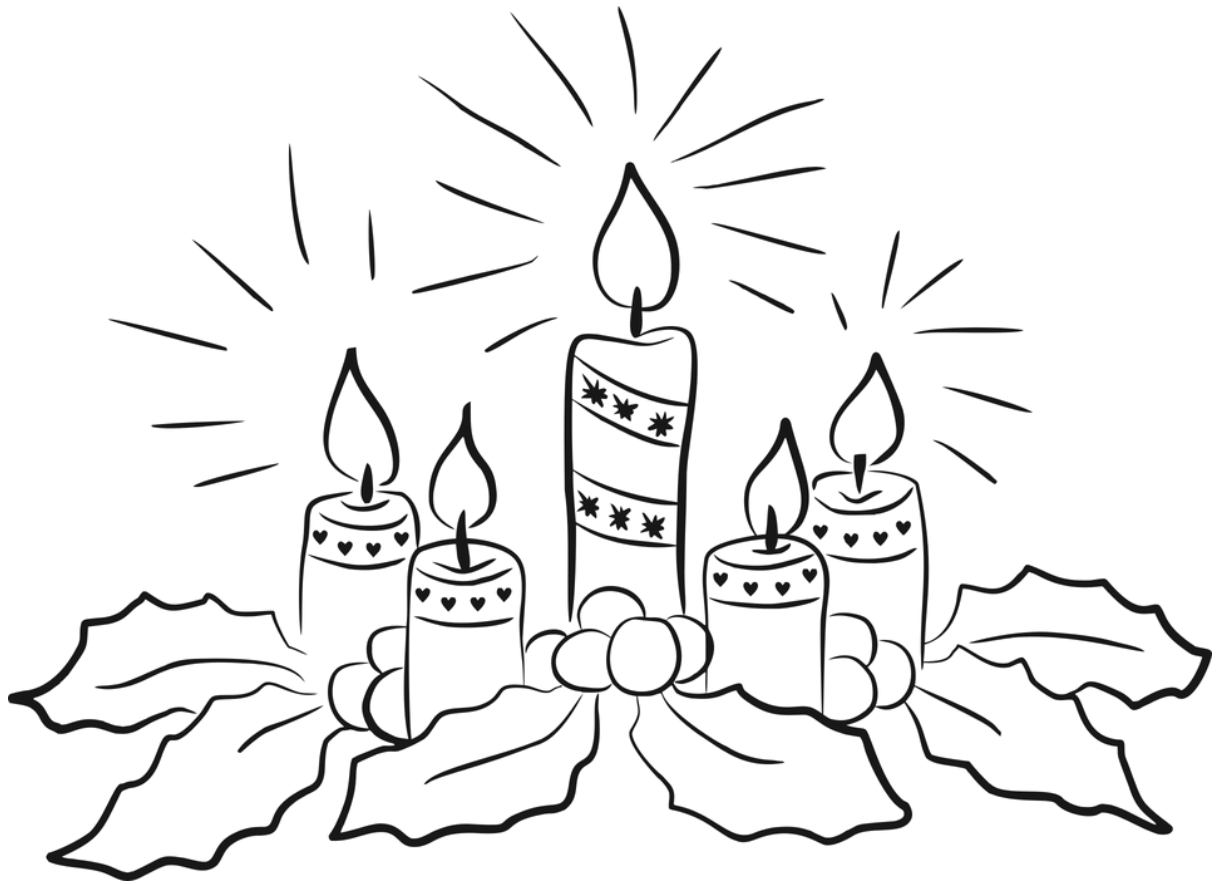
