

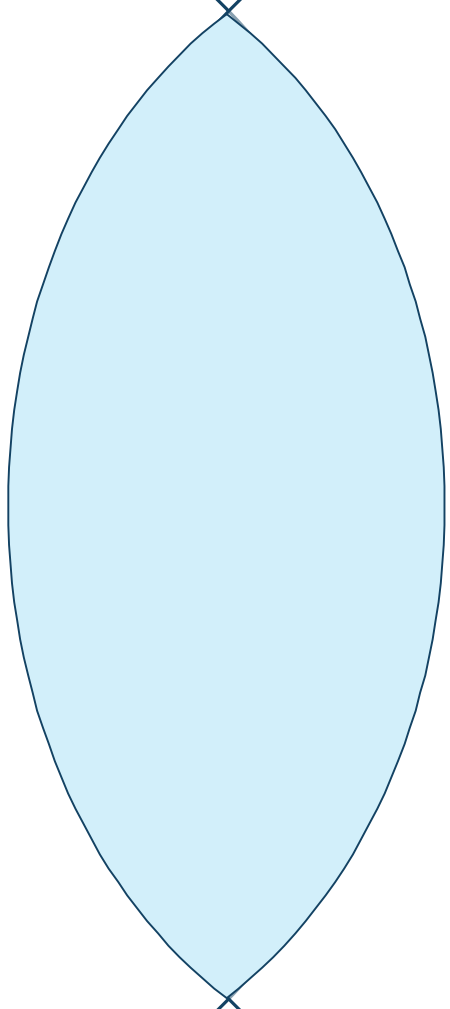
Groups in 1500 Ireland

- Venn diagram templates are available on the next slide. (See a more complex Venn diagram on slide 5)

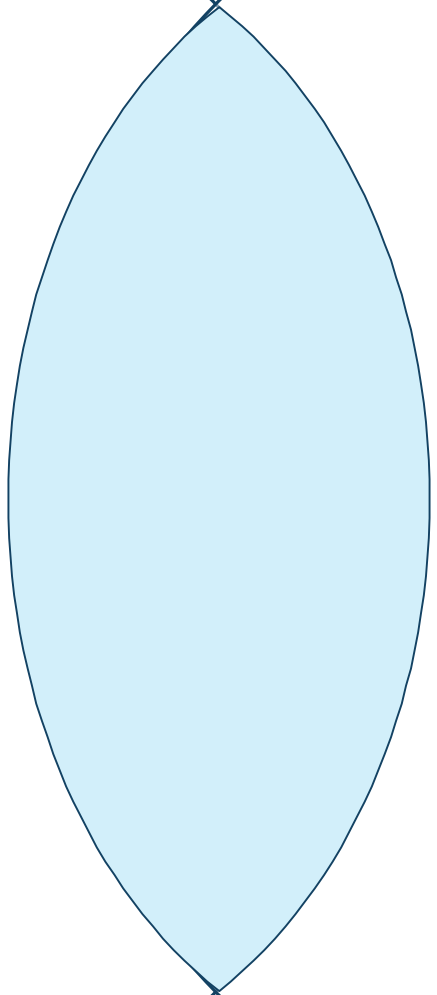

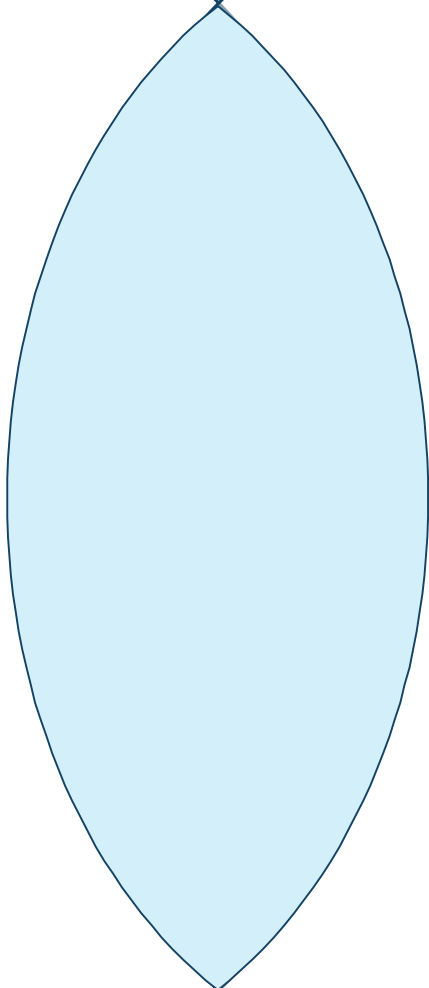

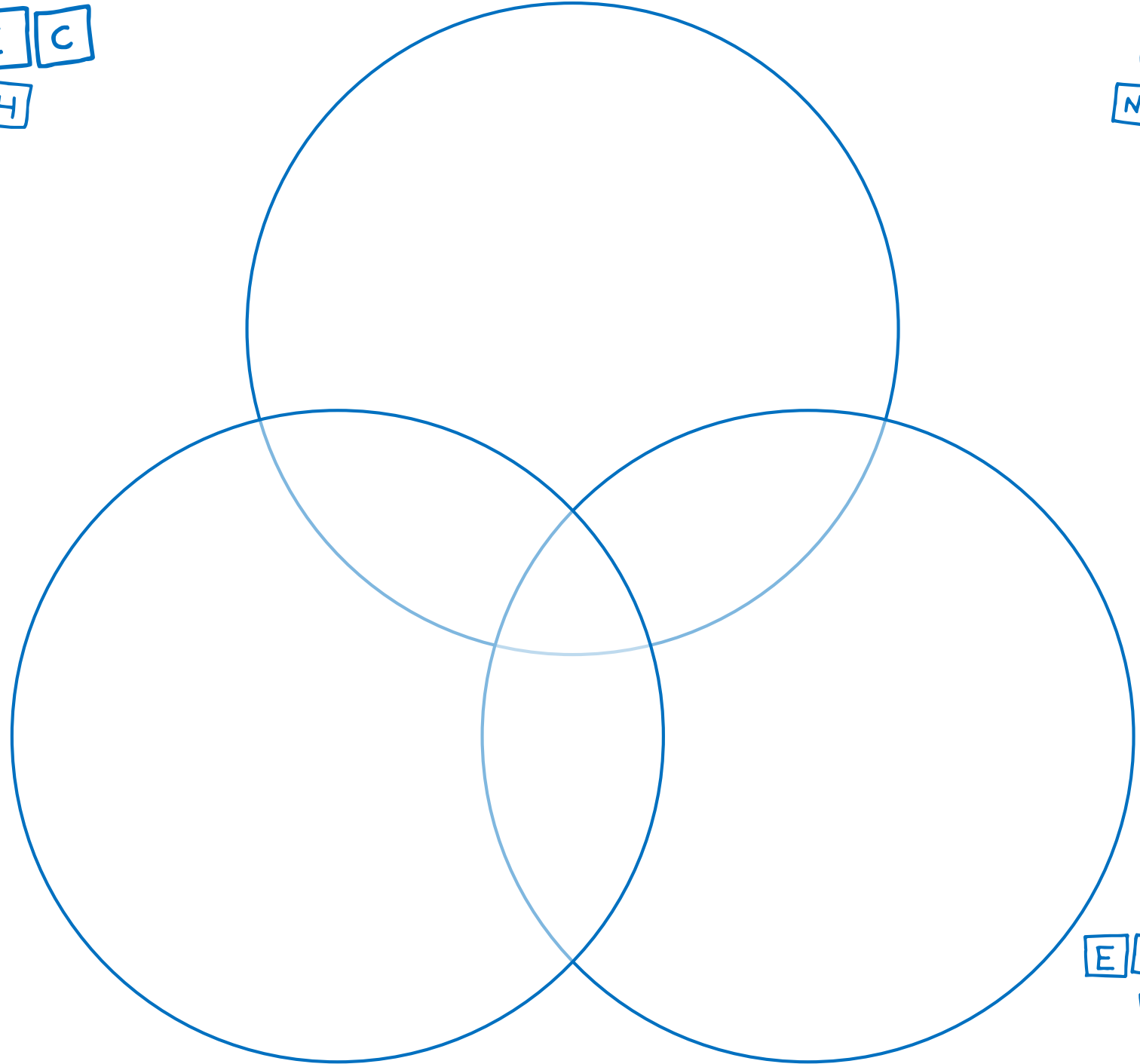




