Q2. Apart from the North Strand, what other parts of Dublin were hit by bombs on Saturday 31st May, 1941?

Q3. Between what times on were the bombs dropped on Dublin?

Q4. What happened to the buildings after they were hit by bombs? Why was this necessary?

Q5. How many people were left homeless after the bombings?

Q6. It was very difficult for planes to navigate in 1941. The German government told the Irish government that the pilot made a mistake and bombed the wrong city.
