Example 1

Q. Simplify: $(14x^3 - 29x^2 - x + 6) \div (2x - 1)$

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$$\therefore (14x^3 - 29x^2 - x + 6) \div (2x - 1)$$

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$$\therefore (14x^3 - 29x^2 - x + 6) \div (2x - 1) = 7x^2 - 11x - 6$$
