
## **Weather Recording Sheet**

With the help of your teacher, set up and record information from a school weather station on the chart below. Weather stations can be physical devices, made up of many individual pieces of equipment, or they can be electronic. If a weather station is not available in your school, you can collate the information from the internet or local newspapers.

Before you start, make sure that your weather station is not in direct sun or shade, as this could affect your recordings. You should aim to take the recordings at the same time every day.



Overtime patterns should emerge showing what the weather is like in your area. You can also construct bar charts and trend graphs from your table of information to see how the following weather measurements have changed over one season or the year. Remember to use weekly or monthly averages. Soon you might be able to predict the weather in your area!
