Kinship	Blood relationship that exists between family members.			
Norms	Normal patterns of behaviour expected to be followed by society i.e. manners			
Values	Attitudes and beliefs held by a society on what is right and wrong. Reinforced by laws.			
Socialisation	Definition: Process where we learn norms, values, behaviour and social skills in order to behave in a manner acceptable to society • Primary: within family • Secondary: outside i.e. work/school			
Socioeconomic group	Classification of individual according to their economic and social position in relation to others. Based on income, education and occupation Higher, middle or lower.
