3. Read the advertisement about the City of Arts and Sciences, Valencia. Answer in English. (Spanish example).

In question 3 or 4 students can be asked to answer questions on a person/ place.


An image of a place or a person and a text describing general information or their background, interests, hobbies, job, birth date is given.

Numbers, months, days, colours, hobbies, jobs, brothers and sisters are commonly asked.

## Key A: booking accommodation

I made and recorded a phone call to book accommodation in my chosen language.
