# Step 1: Prompt Engineering

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Regardless of the AI you choose to use; Chatgpt, Google Gemini, Microsoft Edge Copilot etc. you need to become adept at ***prompt engineering***. This essentially means the precise instructions you give the AI to get the desired output.

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Once you as a teacher have mastered prompt engineering it should be taught to students also, so they too can use AI as an effective learning tool.

# Prompt Engineering

While GenAI might help teachers and researchers generate useful text and other outputs to support their work, it is not necessarily a straightforward process. It can take multiple iterations of a prompt before the desired output is achieved.

# USE THE ACRONYM 'PREPARE' TO HELP YOU PROMPT

P – Prompt

R – Role

E – Explicit

P –  
Parameters

A – Ask

R – Rate

E –  
Emotion

# PREPARE

## Prompt

Start with a clear question. Provide a stage for what follows.

## Role

Give it a role to help build context for the AI

## Explicit

Be clear and specific about what you want it to do or what information you're looking for.

## Parameters

Define the scope and boundaries of the answer  
e.g. tone of voice, format of output, reading age

# PREPARE

Ask

Ask the AI to provide clarification questions that may improve its response

Rate

Ask the AI to rate its own output and to give evidence for this rating.

Emotion

Appeal to its emotional side

# Sample Class Activity - using AI to refine Poetry Essay Introduction writing skills.

- Students write their own introduction to a poetry essay for a poet on the course.
- Copy the format of the sample prompt on the next slide to a Generative AI of their choice (students may also work in pairs, using two different AI's; for example, copilot and Google Gemini, to see which produces the better paragraph).
- Compare the Generative AI output to their own and use the following questions as a guide:
  - - What are the differences?
  - - What are the similarities?
  - - How can I improve my language?
  - - How can I focus more on the question?

# Sample Prompt

- Write an introduction to the following Leaving Certificate Poetry Essay:

- Afterwards provide clarification questions that you may improve your response. Rate your output and give evidence for this rating.
